Our dynamic group of schools values the unique skills and personalities of all our students. We strive to provide the very best care and opportunities for students with an Education and Health Care Plan (EHCP). Many of our students have social, emotional and mental health needs (SEMH), a diagnosis of attention deficit disorder (ADHD), autism (ASD) or other needs.

We offer a stimulating environment with experienced staff who are dedicated to meeting the needs of all students. Our wider team includes a fully qualified SENCO and speech and language and occupational therapists who are based in the schools.

- The support for students to make the transition to the next stage of their lives.

Seva South Harrow

At our South Harrow site, we cater for the needs of students from the age of 7 to 16 years (Key Stages 2 to 4). All our classes are led by a qualified teacher supported by teaching assistants. There are usually between 8 and 10 students in a class, arranged by age and needs.

We aim to provide a broad and balanced curriculum that supports both the academic and social, emotional and mental health needs of all learners. The full range of national curriculum subjects are offered, differentiated to meet the needs of all learners. An emphasis is placed on developing the literacy and mathematical skills that students will need to be successful in later life and so these subjects are taught daily.





Social and emotional skills are taught explicitly by staff using tried and tested programmes such as Zones of Regulation, Talkabout and LEANS (Learning about neuro diversity in school). These schemes help individuals to develop the skills that will allow them to be successful in the wider community.


At Seva we try to encourage students to maintain a healthy lifestyle and develop their wellbeing. PE is taught weekly as are swimming lessons at a local pool. The chance to cultivate and grow plants is available on our own allotments and we are also currently developing our Forest School.

Further Education - Neasden

Our Further Education site in Neasden provides a safe and nurturing environment for young adults from 16 to 25 years of age (Key Stage 5).

At this site we offer a range of formal learning opportunities and life skills classes designed to allow students to become confident and valued members of their communities.

Students are typically taught in groups of 4-5, with a qualified teacher supported by several experienced teaching assistants, depending on need.

Formal lessons are aimed at developing reading, writing and mathematical skills with students able to sit exams to achieve formal qualifications where appropriate.

Students can access vocational courses that can lead to work experience opportunities in the local community or the chance for students to develop their skills into their own potential businesses. Individuals are supported to apply their skills and knowledge in our own café and allotments.



Many of our young people want to gain the skills and knowledge to be able to live independently in the future. Life-skills and independent living sessions are designed to allow students to become confident in a range of areas from cooking and nutrition to managing finances.

Many of the formal, vocational and life-skills learning can gain accreditation through ASDAN or AQA Units of Work.


