


London Eye Class have been studying Ancient Egypt. They made jewellery in the style of the Ancient Egyptians.





A beautiful piece of Egyptian artwork produced by Susan in London Eye Class Some 'Gothic' style writing by Sanam in London Eye Class




Data Collection Sheet
